Merit badges

Merit badges are a very important and commonly overlooked part of BSA. These are required to get your eagle rank.

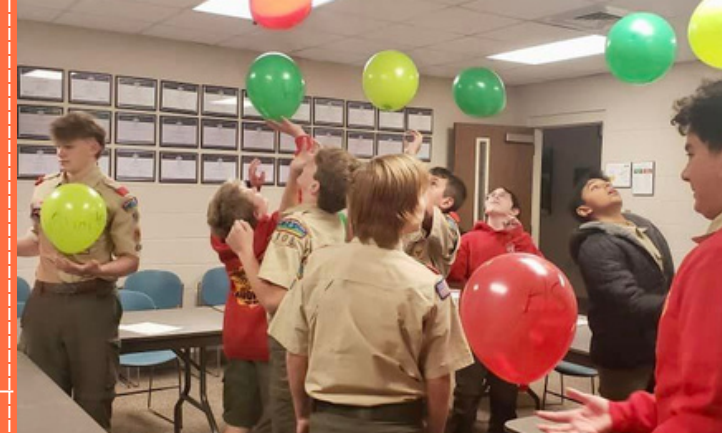
To begin a merit badge, reach out to any scoutmaster, who will give you a blue card with some info on how to contact your merit badge counselor. Your counselor will give you more information from there.

Rank requirements

Rank requirements are an **extremely** important part of BSA, and it is common for rank requirements to be overlooked by scouts. Rank requirements are tasks that must be completed and signed off by someone, First Class or above.

Patrol Leader's Council

A Patrol Leaders Council meeting, commonly referred to as a PLC, is a time where all patrol leaders, assistant patrol leaders, and certain other ranks, such as webmasters, come together and talk about planning future meetings, events, and trips.



Board of Review

A BOR, also known as a Board of Review, is a conference held during a PLC. This is where you come together with upper ranks, such as, but not limited to, assistant scoutmasters and other scouts.
